ROOT ROT



Root rot and collar rot can be caused by a number of things including planting too deeply in the soil or heavy rain and humidity in the warmer months. As a preventative, always plant high in pots and in the ground no deeper than the plant was when you purchased it. Keep mulch away from the stem or trunk of your tree creating a mulch ring the shape of a flattened doughnut, rather than a volcano. Mancozeb is an effective system fungicide used to treat Rot.
